INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Fill in up to your top 5 skills in each column, write them in the grey areas.
- 2. On the bottom row, tally the number of answers (skills) you gave for the column above. Example, If you wrote only 3 skills in a column then that number on the bottom line should be 3.
- 3. Based on the number you wrote in the bottom line of each column, rate all your skills in the column above based on that number. If you wrote 3, then each skill must be rated from 1-3 with 3 being the highest and 1 the lowest of how you would rate each skill based on the question asked for that column. No two skills must have the same number in a column.
- 4. Now it's time to decide your final answer, and there are two ways to determine this. Both by tallying or by yielding to the result the exercise reveals.
 - a. If you see that there is one skill being repeated in all three categories, then that should be your answer regardless of what rating you gave it in each column. If this is case and that skill is being rated lower than another skill in a column, then it means this is an area that you need to work to improve on.
 - b. If there are more than one skills being repeated in all three categories, then you will have to do the tally method to determine what is the higher possibility. Simply add up the score you gave each skill in all the columns and the one with the highest is the possible choice.
 - c. If there are no skills you find that appear in all the columns but only two, then this is a time to decide if the 3rd column missing is something you could work on to bring that skill to the top of your list. Again, if this is happening with more than one skills, then do the tally method again to determine which is the more likely choice.
- 5. This assignment will not be fully completed until you join a live zoom class to discuss your answers and decision. This should be your next class or look to see when this live class is next available.
